

# The Clash Between Emerging & Establishment Religions Textual Evidence

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## THE NEW TESTAMENT

1 Thessalonians 2:14: "...the Jews, who killed both the Lord Jesus and the prophets, and drove us out, and displease God and oppose all men by hindering us from speaking to the Gentiles that they may be saved – so as always to fill up the measure of their sins."

### Matthew 23

<sup>13</sup>Alas for you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! You shut the door of the kingdom of Heaven in people's faces; you do not enter yourselves, and when others try to enter, you stop them.

<sup>15</sup>Alas for you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! You travel over sea and land to win one convert; and when you have succeeded you make him twice as fit for hell as you are yourselves...

<sup>27</sup>Alas for you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! You are like tombs covered with whitewash; they look fine on the outside, but inside they are full of dead men's bones and of corruption. <sup>28</sup>So it is with you: outwardly you look like honest men, but inside you are full of hypocrisy and lawlessness...

<sup>31</sup>So you acknowledge that you are the sons of those who killed the prophets. <sup>32</sup>Go on then, finish off what your fathers began! <sup>33</sup>Snakes! Vipers' brood! How can you escape being condemned to hell?

### John 8

<sup>37</sup> 'I know that you are descended from Abraham, yet you are bent on killing me because my teaching makes no headway with you. <sup>38</sup>I tell what I have seen in my Father's presence; you do what you have learned from your father.' <sup>39</sup>They retorted, 'Abraham is our father.' 'If you were Abraham's children,' Jesus replied, 'you would do as Abraham did. <sup>40</sup>As it is, you are bent on killing me, because I have told you the truth, which I heard from God. That is not how Abraham acted. <sup>41</sup>You are doing your own father's work.'

They said, 'We are not illegitimate; God is our father, and God alone.' <sup>42</sup>Jesus said to them, 'If God were your father, you would love me, for God is the source of my being, and from him I come. I have not come of my own accord; he sent me. <sup>43</sup>Why do you not understand what I am saying? It is because my teaching is beyond your grasp. <sup>44</sup>Your father is the devil and you choose to carry out your father's desires. He was a murderer from the beginning, and is not rooted in the truth; there is no truth in him. When he tells a lie he is speaking his own language, for he is a liar and the father of lies. <sup>45</sup>But because I speak the truth, you do not believe me. <sup>46</sup>Which of you can convict me of sin? If what I say is true, why do you not believe me? <sup>47</sup>He who has God for his father listens to the words of God. You are not God's children, and that is why you do not listen.'

## THE QUR'AN

### Sūra 38 (ṣād)

<sup>4</sup>So they were surprised that a warner has come to them from among them. Those unbelievers say, "This is a lying conjuror!"  
<sup>5</sup>Has he made the deities into one God? This is indeed a strange thing!" <sup>6</sup>The chiefs among them go around saying, "God and be persistent with your gods. This is certainly something concocted." <sup>7</sup>We have not heard such a thing among people recently. It is only a fabrication."

### Sūra 8 (Spoils of War)

<sup>30</sup>And when the unbelievers have plotted against you to arrest you, kill you or drive you out, while they plot, God plots too; and God is the better of the planners. <sup>31</sup>And when Our signs are recited to them, they say, "We've heard. If we wanted, we could say something similar to that. It is only myths of the ancients." <sup>32</sup>And when they say, "O God, if this is indeed the truth from You, then rain down stones upon us or bring us a painful affliction." <sup>33</sup>But God would not punish them while you among them, and God would not punish them while they sought forgiveness. <sup>34</sup>But what excuse do they have that God not punish them when they block entry from the sacred mosque. Were they not its keepers? Its keepers must be those who are true to God, but most of them do not know. <sup>35</sup>And their prayer in the House was nothing but whistling and clapping. So taste the affliction for your denying. <sup>36</sup>Those who deny spend their wealth to block [others] from the path of God. So they will spend it. Then distress will be upon them, and then they will be overcome. And those who denied will be herded into hell.

### Numbers 22-23

<sup>1</sup> The Hebrew root for this term is *herem*, meaning both prohibition and sacredness. In the context of war it denotes dedication to God. If it is man or animal, it should be sacrificed, and if property, devoted to God (Ex.22:19; Lev.27:29); Deut.13:16; 1Sam. 15:3). This meaning is found also in the Mesha Stele. By the Second Temple period and later, it acquired the meaning of expulsion and confiscation of property (Ezra 10:8).
